Hyper Analytical Software Privacy Policy

Hyper Analytical Software LLC ("**Hyper Analytical Software**") is committed to protecting the privacy of personal information provided in connection with its web site at www.hyperanalytical.com (the "Site").

This Privacy Policy provides an overview of Hyper Analytical Software's practices surrounding collection, disclosure and use of personal information in connection with the Site.

Hyper Analytical Software may operate other web sites that provide certain services, including the freedom to operate web-based search service at www.ftosearch.com. These web sites and associated web-based services are governed by a separate Privacy Policy and are not governed by this Privacy Policy.

Information Collected

You are required to provide your name and e-mail address when requesting information about the Site and any software or services of Hyper Analytical Software. You may also provide your company or organization name when requesting information from Hyper Analytical Software through the Site.

Cookies, Tracking Technologies, and Analytics Tools

Hyper Analytical Software uses cookies to store information about visitors to the Site, such as viewing preferences. A cookie is a data file that a web site writes to your computer when you visit the Site.

We also may use pixel tags, web beacons and other similar technologies to improve our understanding of site traffic, visitor behavior, and response to promotional campaigns, as a supplement to our server logs and other methods of traffic and response measurement. Pixel tags are sometimes used in conjunction with small Javascript-based applications, which are also for the purpose of traffic measurement. We may also implement pixel tags provided by other companies, for the same purpose. The information we obtain in this manner enables us to customize the Site and to measure the overall effectiveness of the Site and associated web site and web activities.

Hyper Analytical Software gathers information about web site visitors collectively and logs IP addresses, session sources, and other data that track access to the Site. We analyze these logs to better understand aggregate behavior and to monitor performance of our Site. The logs are analyzed to ascertain the overall aggregate trends they reveal about our visitors, but not as a means of tracking the behavior of individual users outside our Site. This information is used for the purposes of maintaining and improving the Site.

Use and Disclosure of Collected Information

We do not sell, rent, use or share your personal information with others except as set forth in this Privacy Policy.

Hyper Analytical Software may use personal information to provide information about our products and services to you.

You agree that we may communicate with you via email and similar technologies for any purpose relating to the Site.

Hyper Analytical Software may use aggregate and/or de-identified information to determine the demographics of our visitors and to use and distribute statistics and general information about the Site. These demographics will always represent aggregate and/or anonymized information and will not identify a specific individual.

Hyper Analytical Software may also disclose and use personal information:

- when we have your permission to do so;
- to companies who work for Hyper Analytical Software to provide one or more parts of the Site or that provide related administrative functions.
